APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Consult your Mobile Paint Representative for the protective coating system best suited for your requirements.

Limitations: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply in good weather when air and surface temperature are above 50°F and surface temperature is at least 5°F above the dew point. For optimum application properties, material should be between 70 to 100°F prior to mixing and application. Maintain unmixed material in closed containers in protected storage at 40 - 100°F. Do not apply to uncured wood. Do not apply late in the afternoon or when there is a threat of rain or moisture condensing on the uncured paint. Do not apply in direct sun or on hot surfaces. Do not use on wood that will be in contact with food, feed, potable water or prolonged dermal (skin) contact. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use where dairy cattle or livestock can come in contact with the treated wood. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

Surface Preparation - New or previously unpainted wood: Good surface preparation is essential to a satisfactory coating system. Trapped internal moisture is the main cause of blistering paint. Vent problem areas prior to painting. Surfaces to be coated should be clean and dry. Remove all dirt, dust, oil, grease, mildew, or other contamination. Remove mildew by scrubbing with a solution of 3 tablespoons of non-ammoniated dry household laundry detergent and 1 quart hypochlorite bleach in 1 gallon of warm water. Protective gloves, clothing and goggles should be worn when using this solution to avoid skin and eye irritation. Quickly wash off any of the solution that touches your skin. After scrubbing, rinse thoroughly with water and allow to dry.

Previously Painted Surfaces: Not recommended for application to primed, previously painted or otherwise sealed surfaces. All previous paint or sealer must be completely removed before using this product.

Tinting: Do not tint.

Mixing: This is a one component coating. Always mix thoroughly with a power agitator before application.

Thinning: This product is supplied at normal brushing or dipping viscosity. If thinning is necessary, use water sparingly.

Application: Apply by brush, dipping or low pressure spray. Apply at a spreading rate of approximately 300 square feet per gallon. All wood in contact with the earth or secured to concrete slabs should receive two coats for proper protection. Thoroughly coat joints, cracks, cut ends, holes or other openings in wood. For best results, fence posts, poles, foundations, timbers and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned before treating. Immerse in the product for a period of 12 to 48 hours.

Equipment: Brush - Use a good quality bristle brush. Spray - May be applied with conventional "garden-type" sprayer or with airless spray equipment operated at low pressure. Care should be exercised to avoid over-atomization and application of preservative to surfaces other than those which are to be treated.

Cleanup: Clean all equipment immediately after use with warm, soapy water. Completely flush all spray equipment with this solution. Occasional flushing of spray equipment during the course of the working day helps prevent buildup and possible clogging. Final flushing with mineral spirits may prevent corrosion.

Storage and Disposal: - Prohibitions - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage -** Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container only. Close container after each use. Keep in a locked storage area and out of reach of children. **Pesticide Disposal -** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. **Container Disposal -** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Safety: Safe storage, handling and use dictate that adequate health and safety precautions be observed with this product and any recommended thinners. User is specifically directed to consult the current Material Safety Data Sheet for this product as well as precautions contained on product labeling.
